GENERAL INFORMATION

Activities, clubs and open forums at C.V.H.S. are operated under District and ASB guidelines. District sponsored programs are those programs which are financially supported by the District and are designated by an *.

A list of C.V.'s clubs is presented below along with a brief description of the purpose of each. Major activities are selected by the officers and approved by the group's sponsor. Meeting schedules are listed, but time commitments may vary depending on the group's activities.

Dues are determined by the group's officers and approved by the sponsor. Most clubs have minimal dues. **No students will be denied membership in any group, club, or athletic team because of financial hardship.** Clubs, athletic teams, and other school groups may have periodic fundraising efforts. The Associated Student Body officers and faculty representative must approve any fundraising effort.

Parents/guardians will be notified if any activities require the use of travel and/or transportation prior to the approved activity.

Under present law, a group of students have the right to meet and request an adult observer assigned by the principal. These groups must follow a number of rules enforced by the principal, but they are not necessarily endorsed or sponsored by the school. Examples of such groups are prayer groups and study groups. We are notifying you of all current groups so you can give your student guidance on whether he or she should attend.

American Cancer Society Youth	Open to students interested in learning more about causes, effects, and treatments of cancer. (Meets 1 time a month)
American Sign Language	Open to students interested in learning sign language. (Meets 2 times a month)
Armenian Club	Open to all students interested in sharing Armenian cultures and customs. (Meets 2 times per month.)
Art Club	Open to all students interested in art. (Meets 2 time per month.)
California Scholarship Federation	Membership based upon academic grades. (Meets 1 time per month.)
Falcon Christian Fellowship	Open to all students interested in sharing knowledge of the Christian faith. (Meets 2 times per month)
Falcon Democrats	Meets to discuss current political issues. (Meets 2 times a month)
Falcon Republicans	Meets to discuss current political issues. (Meets 2 times a month)
Fellowship of Christian Athletes	Open to all students and focuses on Christian beliefs through the avenue of athletics. (Meets 2 times per month)
Film Institute	Open to students interested in the film industry. (Meets 1 time per month)
French Club	Open to all students interested in understanding the French speaking world's cultures, peoples, and customs. (Meets 1 times per month .)
Gay/Straight Alliance	An organization open to all students to promote a better understanding of and communication between gay and straight youth. (Meets 2 times per month.)
German Club	Open to all students interested in understanding the German culture, peoples, and customs. (Meets 2 times per month.)
Girls' League	Open to all girls enrolled at C.V. wishing to become involved in planning activities for girls. (Meets 2 times per month.)

Green Earth Club	Open to all students interested in preserving the earth and our campus. (Meets 2 times a month.)
International Thespian Society	Students must participate in 2 mainstage theater productions for membership. (Meets 1 time a month)
Japanese Culture Club	Open to all students interested in Japanese customs and culture. (Meets 2 times month.)
Junior Statesmen Of America	Open to students interested in expressing views and encourages activity in a non-partisan environment. (Meets 2 times a month.)
Journeys	Open to students selected for the purpose of publishing Journeys, a literary journal of prose. (No fixed meeting schedule.)
Key Club	Open to all students interested in providing service to the school and community. (Meets 2 times per month)
Korean American Club	Open to all students interested in service to Korean –American issues. (Meets 2 times a month.)
Make A Wish	Open to students interested in helping children with life-threatening illnesses (Meets 2 times a month)
Math Club	Open to all students who are enrolled in a geometry or higher math course with a math grade average of at least “B”. (Meets 2 times per month at lunch)
Mock Trial Club	Open to all students wishing to prepare and present a mock law case. (Meets 2 times per week at certain times of the year)
Music and Musicians	Open to all students interested in listening, playing and discussing music. (Meets 2 times a month)
National Honor Society	Membership by invitation. Student must be a junior or senior, maintain a 3.5 GPA and be active in school and community affairs and service. (Meets once a month)
Pre-Medical Society	Open to students interested in the medical profession.
Robot Club	Open to all students interested in designing and building robots. (Meets 2 times a month)
Save Uganda	Open to all students interested in raising funds and awareness for Uganda (Meets 2 times a month)
Spanish Club	Open to all students enrolled in Spanish classes. (Meets 2 times per month)
Speech and Debate Club	Open to all students interested in participating in school and extra curricular speaking and debating activities. (Meets 2 times per month at lunch)
The following activities are open to students on a try-out basis:	
Advanced Dance*	Meets daily as class. Time commitment includes community performances, evening practices and performances, school assemblies, etc. Expected contribution is approximately \$100 for costumes.
Band and Orchestra*	Meets daily as a class. Time commitment includes parades, providing music for athletic events, evening practices and performances, etc. Students may use their own instruments or those provided by the District. Expected contribution is minimal.
Choir*	Meets daily as a class. Time commitment includes community performances, evening practices and performances, choir tour. Expected contributions are defrayed in large part by fundraisers.

- Drama** Meets daily as a class. Time commitment includes evening practices and performances in plays and musicals.
- Journalism*** Meets daily as class. Time commitment involves afternoon and evening work to meet deadlines for school newspaper.
- Pep Squad/
Pep Flags *** Meets daily as class. Time commitment includes parades, athletic events, school assemblies, and other community activities in the evenings, and summer camp. Expected contribution is approximately \$300.
- Yearbook *** Meets daily as class. Time commitment includes afternoon and evening work to meet publisher's deadlines.

No students will be denied membership in any group, club, or athletic team because of financial hardship.

Athletic Teams * Meet daily as classes. Time commitment includes participation in athletic events as well as practice outside the class period, including Saturday and early mornings. Expected contributions vary from sport to sport, and some costs are offset by fundraising; see individual coaches for details. Students may have the opportunity to purchase game clothing, but this is optional. Students are required to have annual physical exams, proof of health insurance, and parent consent to participate.
